First Care Women's Clinic is an evangelical Christian, non-profit organization that reduces abortion by providing the services, support, and information that men and women need to choose life for their unborn children.

Our story began in 1985, overwhelmed and appalled by the number of women choosing to abort their precious babies. We opened our doors to give hope, help and support to women facing unplanned pregnancies. We believe, as you do, that every child is created by God with eternal value and deserves life!

Today, we are an accredited clinic offering the medical services sexually active women are seeking. We are dedicated to helping women understand that abortion is not their only option, even before they are forced to make a pregnancy decision. By incorporating STI testing and pelvic swabs, we have expanded our reach to speak into the lives of thousands of women who are at risk.

Thanks to the generosity of local churches, organizations, and passionate individuals, we supported approximately 2,500 women and men with life affirming care in 2023!

Restoring the "Care" in Healthcare

While Planned Parenthood hides the humanity of the unborn from mothers, we show them the truth. Our approach to healthcare starts with compassionate and confidential services provided by medical professionals. Following a positive pregnancy test, our ultrasounds reveal the life growing inside each mother's womb.

First Care Women's Clinic distinguishes itself with a remarkable 87% of abortion-minded women choosing life for their babies after receiving ultrasounds. This remains true when a fetal heartbeat is not detected! While legally these women can still obtain an abortion in Georgia, their experience at our clinic pierces their hearts with the truth. They realize their womb does not just contain a clump of cells, but a precious baby worthy of love and protection!

"I found out I was pregnant and it was very unexpected. I had plans of course to keep the baby, but a little fear set in. I was considering aborting because I wasn't sure how the situation would play out with my partner. He was okay with whatever I decided.

For me to even consider abortion at a time like this in my life, I did feel a little bit uneasy... but I was really going to go through with it.

I found First Care and was really surprised at everything that was offered. We heard the heartbeat... and that's when my heart just completely dropped and I was like, I can't go through with an abortion. I'm just glad that I didn't!"

Leslie Becomes Passionately Pro-Life

“My first option and my only option that I was told was to get rid of him. I actually had an abortion set up in Washington. When I saw my son up on the screen in front of me on the ultrasound at First Care, he was sucking his thumb and that was the first thing I saw. Hearing that he was healthy, it was like a weight was lifted off of my shoulders to know that I actually had a healthy baby inside of me after everything that I had done to my body.

You guys gave me other options other than termination. When the DC office explained to me the process of what you have to do for an abortion late term, it was disgusting. They put a foot long needle in your stomach to kill your child.

There are other women in this world that are doing that still every single day. They are being told that’s their only option, and it’s not! Y’all’s name needs to be everywhere because you guys made a massive difference in my life.

I started getting involved at church and got baptized in Jesus’ name three months after I had Keenan. Then two months later his father and I got married. Now I’m pregnant with baby #2 and I am very excited!”

Asharia Refuses to Abort Her Son

"Initially, I was very excited to be pregnant. When I told the dad, he wasn't asking, he was just telling me to get an abortion. It got to the point where he said, "You can't force me to be a dad." Some of my family members said, "You're not ready, you're making the wrong choice." It was really hard.

God is a very important part of my life. This happened for a reason. God wouldn't have me take care of a whole child if I couldn't do it. My faith helped me through every step of the way.

From the very first appointment at First Care, everyone was just super kind and super understanding. I got set up with the Bright Courses so they helped me be financially and emotionally ready. I felt like I had an amazing support system.

I'm in school for nursing. I took a break when I had Cameron, but I am going back in January.

Just recently we've been able to start going back to church, just in the hallway, like we can't go in because he cries. It's just Cameron 24/7. That's my life right now and I love it."

Our confidential Post-Abortion Healing Class (Surrendering the Secret) is open to anyone seeking freedom from guilt. The class ends with a service at our Memorial Garden at Grace Community Church to honor the lives of children lost to abortion.

Becky Surrenders Her Secret

“I had an abortion at age 19. I had actually just broken up with my boyfriend and my mom was telling me that she wasn't going to help me. I went into Planned Parenthood, and they were saying, it's just tissue, it's not really a baby. I tried to see the baby, but she had turned the screen around the other way. The next thing I know I'm waking back up and it's already been done. I kept just imagining getting up off the table and running. It was too late.”

A lot of Christians don't realize, when you are sitting in the pew, all of the people around you that could possibly be one of those who have had an abortion. You don't know their story.

I had forgiven every person around me, but I had never forgiven myself. The people of First Care Women's Clinic are all so wonderful, and it's not like they want anything in return, it's literally because they know what you've gone through.

You can shut all of the enemy's doors with the help of the clinic and most importantly, with God. Allow Him to shut those doors. Allow Him to heal your heart.”

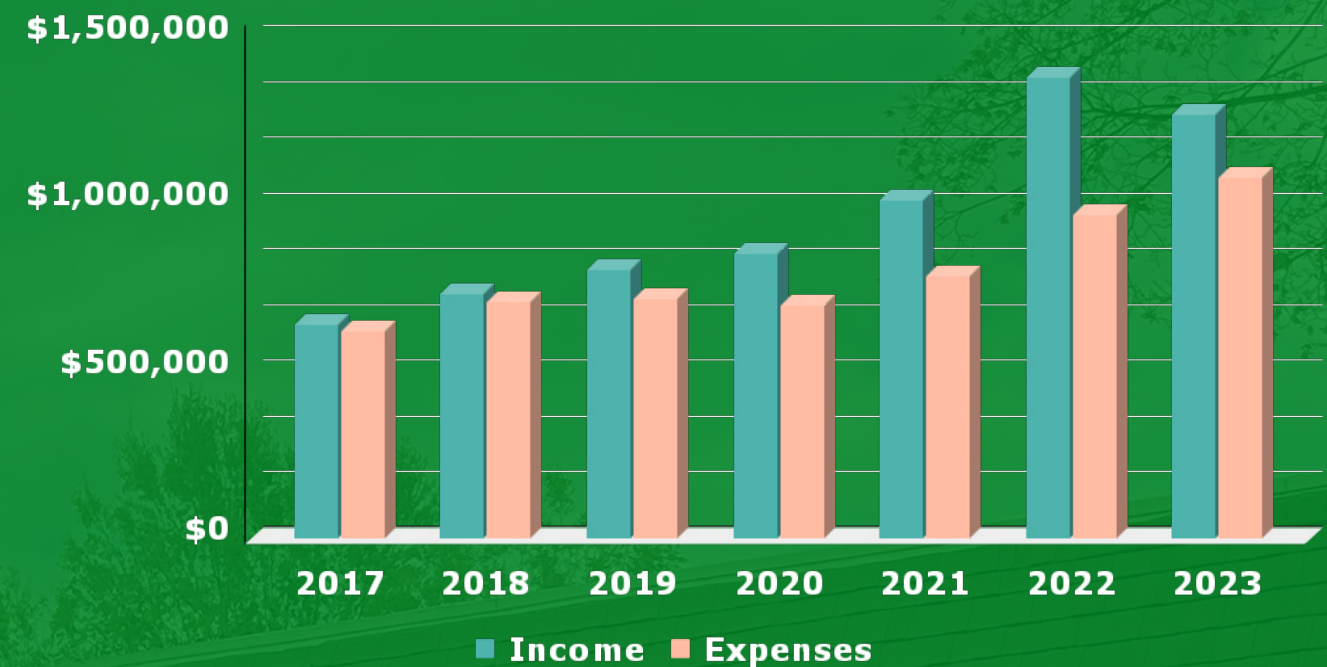

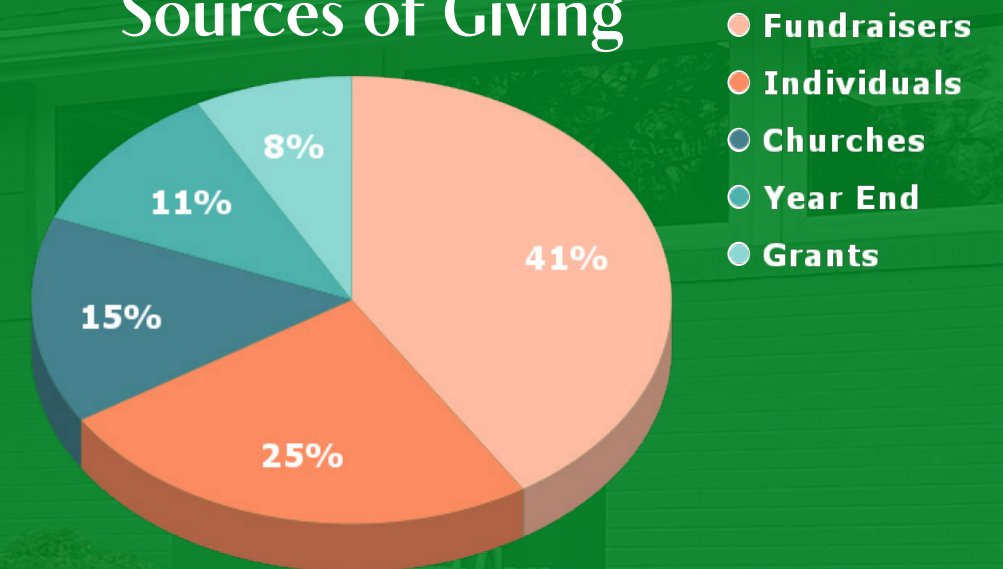

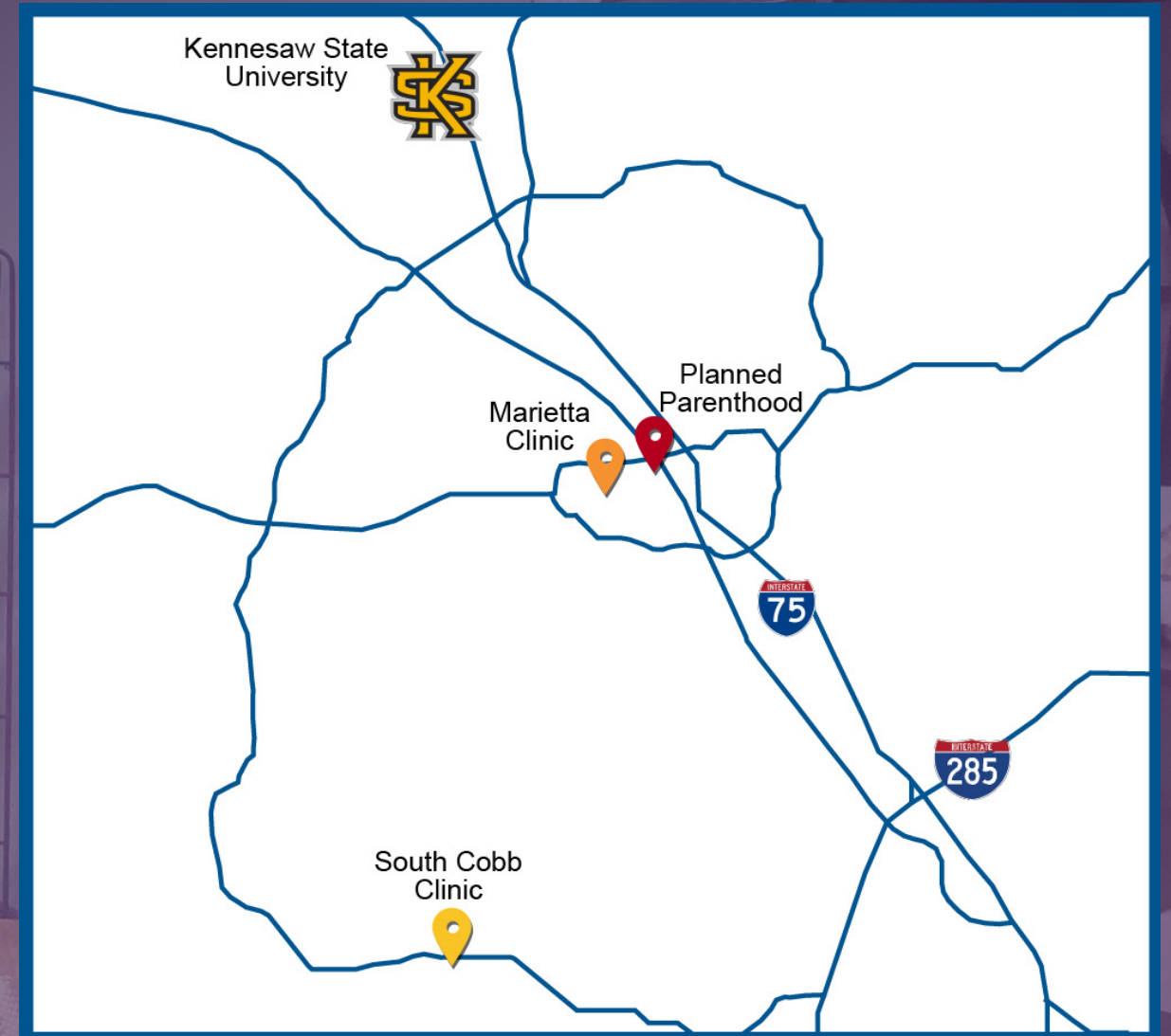
In 2019, we launched fundraising efforts to open a satellite clinic in South Cobb. Soon after, the area received national media attention for sex trafficking and a 674% opioid death increase. This at-risk population is clearly in desperate need of a life-affirming medical clinic. Though the pandemic delayed our efforts, we have signed a lease in our desired area near Cobb Hospital!

South Cobb Clinic Update

- Signed lease with pro-life property manager
- Permitting approved and demolition started
- Hired and trained front office and nursing staff
- Stocked Baby Boutique at Floyd Road Baptist Church

If renovations are completed on time, our doors will open in the spring of 2024.

Together, we are creating a culture of life in Cobb, one family at a time.



Since the average age of women aborting has increased to 25 we want to reach them before they are facing an unplanned pregnancy. We are setting our sights on Kennesaw State University for future expansions.
